#### ORDINANCE NO. 2021-03

### ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBLE BIDDER REQUIREMENTS ON CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Township of Winfield in DuPage County, Illinois. (hereinafter the "Township")

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to preserve administrative resources by ensuring that only qualified contractors and subcontractors are awarded contracts on construction projects; and

WHEREAS, the Township, based upon its Experience, has determined that quality workmanship, efficient operation, safety, and timely completion of projects are not necessarily insured by awarding a construction contract solely on the basis of the low bid; and

WHERAS, the Township seeks to enhance its ability to identify the lowest "responsible bidder" on all construction projects by instituting more comprehensive submission requirements which are in compliance with Illinois law; and

WHEREAS, "An Ordinance Establishing Responsible Bidder Requirements on Construction Projects" will assure efficient use of taxpayer dollars, will promote public safety and is I the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_; also known as Purchasing Policy for Winfield Township, be amended to include:

Responsible bidder for construction contracts means a bidder for construction contracts advertised, awarded, and financed, in whole or in part, with Township public funds, regardless of cost, excluding projects on private property; and who meets all of the job specifications, the following applicable criteria, and submits evidence of such compliance:

- a. All applicable laws prerequisite to doing business in Illinois, and all local ordinances; and not in conflict with any federal law.
- b. Evidence of compliance with
  - (a) Federal Employer Tax Identification Number or Social Security Number (for Individuals)
  - (b) Provision of Section 2000(e) of Chapter 21, Title 42 of the United States Code and Federal Executive Order No. 11246 as amended by Executive Order No. 11375 (known as the Equal Opportunity Employer provisions).
  - (c) Certificates of insurance indicating the following coverages; general liability, workers' compensation, completed operations, and automobile.

- (d) Compliance with all provisions and exemptions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, including wages, medical and hospital insurance and retirement for those in the trades covered in the Act.
- (e) Discloser of the name and address of each subcontractor from whom the contractor has accepted a bid and/or intends to hire on any part of the project prior to the subcontractor commencing work on the project.
- (f) The bidder and all bidders' sub-contractors must participate in active apprenticeship and training programs approved and registered with the United States Department of labor's Office of Apprenticeship for each of the trades of work contemplated under the award contract.
- (g) Evidence of participation in apprenticeship training programs applicable to the work to be preformed on the project, which are approved and registered wit the United States Department of Labor's Office of Apprenticeship, or its successor organization; and evidence that any applicable apprenticeship program has graduated at least five (5) apprentices in each of the construction crafts the bidder will preform on the project. Evidence of graduation rates are not required for apprenticeship crafts dedicated exclusively to the transportation of material and equipment to and from the project. The required evidence includes but is not limited to a copy of all applicable Apprenticeship Agreement(s) for any apprentice(s) who will perform work on the project.
- (h) All contractors and sub-contractors are required to turn in certified payrolls as specified in Illinois Public act 94-0515, and follow all provisions of the Employee Classification Act, 820ILCS 185/1 et seq.
- (i) All bidders must identify projects of a similar nature as being performed in the immediate past years with the name, address and telephone number of the contact person having knowledge of the integrity and business practices of the contractor.

(j)

BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED, that nothing herein hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit of proceeding now pending in any court of any rights accrued or liability inured or caused or causes of action accrued of existing under any prior Resolution or Ordinance. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by the Ordinance.

BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance amendment shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption, excluding those contracts advertised or awarded before this date.

## RESOLUTION 2021-2 RESOLUTION FOR DEPOSITORIES FOR FUNDS FOR WINFIELD TOWNSHIP

Be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of Winfield Township, DuPage County, Illinois, that the following Federally Insured Depository Institutions are hereby designated as the depositories of the funds of Winfield Township, and that the Elected Officials of said Winfield Township are hereby authorized to endorse, in the name of Winfield Township for the purpose of deposit and collection in and with said Federally Insured Depository Institutions, checks, drafts, notes and other like obligations, issued or drawn to and owned by Winfield Township, and it is further resolved that endorsements for deposit and collection may be by the written or stamped endorsement of Winfield Township without designation of the party making the endorsement.

Republic Bank IMET (Illinois Metropolitan Investment Fund)

Said Federally Insured Depository Institutions are hereby authorized to pay out the funds of Winfield Township on deposit with said Institutions from time to time upon checks drawn upon said Institutions and signed in the name of Winfield Township by its Supervisor or Trustees so authorized and countersigned by its Town Clerk or Trustees so authorized whether said checks are payable to bearer or the order of Winfield Township, or to any third party, or to the order of any signing or countersigning official of Winfield Township or and other official of Winfield Township, in either their individual or official capacity.

The Town Clerk of Winfield Township shall file with the said Institutions a certified copy of this Resolution under the seal of Winfield Township and shall also file with the said Institution a certified list of the persons at the present time holding the elected offices of Township Supervisor, Township Clerk, and Township Board of Trustees of Winfield Township, and it shall be conclusively presumed that the persons so certified as holding such offices continue respectively to hold the same until the said institution is otherwise notified in writing by the Town Clerk of Winfield Township.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect and binding upon Winfield Township until it shall have been rescinded, and written notice of such rescission under the Township Seal shall have been delivered to said Institution.
